New Realities at Stadtmuseum Aarau

What kind of influence does the generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) have on our perception? The special exhibition “New Realities – how AI depicts us” will show us, with photorealistic AI-pictures from the last 3 years, how technique, aesthetic and our comprehension for pictures change us.

“New Realities” offers a critical examination of the possibilities and limits of generative AI – and it motivates us to discover new perspectives on our reality. Together with David Künzli, we will have a ¾ hour English guided tour through these new realities which can be fascinating and frightening at the same time.


The entrance fee is CHF 5.00 (free with Museumspass or Raiffeisen Card), the tour guide is FREE for members, guests pay CHF 10.00.



Slide Show "Madagascar"

Most of you probably have been to the Masoala Hall at Zurich Zoo. If you join Marina for the slide show on Madagascar, you will experience the "real thing". Masoala National Park, founded in 1997, lies on a peninsula in the northeast of Madagascar. Besides its large area of rainforest, marine parks and its variety of habitats, you will also meet the people who live there.

Madagascar is a biodiversity hotspot with over 90 % of all plant and animal species being endemic. We will travel through different territorial ecoregions and also take a train that used to run between Yverdon and St. Croix. The 163 km long railway line is very important for the people who live on this high plateau in order to take their goods to the markets.

To us foreigners it provides an amazing glimpse of local life. In addition to sightseeing, watching lemurs and learning about Madagascar's culture, we also get into contact with the Swiss project ADES whose goal it is that the majority of households will use energy efficient cooking stoves by 2050. They are produced and distributed locally and help to fight deforestation. The slide show takes place at the Restaurant Werdguet, how to get there, see under February 10 (frame on page 4).

The event is FREE of charge for members, guests contribute with CHF 5.00.

Zurich Circular - future with circular economy

A way out is the circular economy! The current exhibition in the Stadthaus Zurich is intended to show the principles of the circular economy in Zurich. 

“Anundpfirsich” the making of improvised theatre

When we go to a theatre performance, we take it for granted that the actors and actresses perform the play according to a script and a perfectly planned choreography. But here in the “Anundpfirsich” Theater zum Zollhaus (apparently derived from the expression “an und für sich”) this works **WITHOUT !!!**

In other words, the actors perform the play spontaneously, in most cases according to the input of the audience. This means that they improvise “live” on the stage when the audience is present and interacting. Improvised theatre is not only an experiment, it’s a science. Thus, the “Anundpfirsich” not only performs theatre but also provides professional workshops and gives lessons.

Tonight, we will have an English guided tour with Björn through the premises of the Theater Zollhaus. He will explain us the concept of the *Impro Theater*, takes about one hour.

Location: Zollstrasse 121, 8005 Zurich. How to get there: You may start from Sihlquai/HB, turn into Zollstrasse, just go along the rails on the north side until you reach no. 121. Or take any Tram to Limmatplatz and change to Bus 32 and get off at Röntgenstrasse, then it’s a 100 meter stroll. The tour costs you a modest CHF 5.00, guests contribute with CHF 15.00.

After the tour, for those who like, we will go to a restaurant near HB (previously the St.Gallerhof) for food or a drink.

Vietnamese Food at Restaurant Co Chin Chin (Gasometerstrasse)

It is a 15h flight to Vietnam from Zurich, a country with many contrasts - and a unique style of cooking. This evening, we do not have to take the aeroplane, it's enough to travel to Gasometerstrasse 7 in Zurich. Restaurant Co Chin Chin offers authentic Vietnamese food. As a starter, what about *Goi Cuon*, a summer roll with shrimp and chicken? It's even available in spring time. The main course dish highly recommended would be a crunchy duck with *pak choy vegetables* or, for vegetarians, a dish called *banh pho xao nam*, i.e. fried noodles with various types of mushrooms. There is also a large choice of soups and salads. To finish off a delicious meal, you may make a choice of 8 different sweet dishes.

Prices for the main dish range from CHF 20 - CHF 35.

Directions how to get there: Take any tram to Limmatplatz. Walk up Langstrasse, turn right into Heinrichstrasse then turn left on the 2nd road into Gasometerstrasse and walk up to the restaurant. 
