in the Café des Ami(e)s, but we don't have to speak French there...



Kill the Indian – save the Man at NONAM Seefeld

"Kill the Indian - save the Man." This was the guiding principle that removed thousands of Native American children and placed them in Indian boarding schools. More than a century later, will these Native American boys finally come home?

The guiding principle also deals with loss of culture, identity and residential schools. Identity – what does this actually mean? And what does culture have to do with identity? In our 1 h English guided tour at the Indian Museum NONAM, you will also learn what TikTok, clans und boarding schools have to do with Indians. How to get there: take tram 2 or 4 or any train to Tiefenbrunnen. Take the railway underpass towards the hillside and follow Seefeldstrasse outbound to # 317.

The entrance fee is CHF 8.00 which you please go and pay at the entrance (the owners of a museum card are asked to bring it along, for them the entrance is free). Besides the entrance fee, for the tour guide, we ask CHF 5.00 for members and

CHF 10.00 for quests in cash.

Guided Tour at Neeracherried Birdlife Centre

Please join me for an organised 1 ½ hour tour in English at the birdlife centre Nerracherried. This tour will give you an informative insight about various birds, frogs, dragon flies and plants with their habitat at Neeracherried as well as the possibility of observing them from protected platforms and pedestrian bridges especially constructed for this purpose.

On site, there are telescopes available, but if you are in possession of your own binoculars, do take them along with you on this occasion. Depending on the weather, make sure you wear adequate clothes and comfortable shoes as well as a drinking bottle. **Space is limited!**

There is a car park available for the drivers, free for 15 hours. GPS address is Dielsdorferstrasse 3, 8173 Neerach.

ÖV: Get a return ticket to Riedt b. Neerach, Riedacher. Timetable: In Zurich HB, take S15 at 16.22 h, arriving

Oberglatt Bhf. at 16.39 h. There, you change to bus 510 (direction Kaiserstuhl AG) leaving at 16.44 h, arriving 16.56 h at bus stop Riedt b. Neerach, Riedacher. I shall meet you there from where we reach the Neeracherried after a 5 minutes walk.

Garden centre and tree nursery Hauenstein AG in Rafz

Almost everybody loves this time of year. First of all there are spring flowers blooming, blossoms and leaves appearing on trees and later on a lot of different flowers and roses in a big variety of colours can be admired. It doesn't matter whether you have a garden, a balcony, windowsills, or you are simply a great nature lover: You will for sure like the English guided tour of about 75 to 90 minutes given at Hauenstein AG in Rafz. More than 130 years ago Walter Hauenstein founded the tree nursery, and the gardening business got added later. Nowadays the garden centre in Rafz has an area of 178'400 sqm with an additional show garden of 10'000 sqm and we get an exclusive insight!

An excursion to Waldshut (DE) Rhine River Ferry – Old Town – Fine Food

Waldshut? Aha! You think of shopping, the cheap € and heavy traffic. The Habsburg town on the German side of the Rhine river can be seen as a suburb of Zurich (they don't like to hear this!) but it still lies a few hills away from us. As this area can be reached by public transport pretty well, we make a varied excursion to Waldshut today.

The programme looks as followed:

- Train ride from Zürich HB to Koblenz (16.06 h 16.43 h)
- Postauto from Koblenz to Full, Fähre (Argovia) (16.46 h 16.49 h)
- In Full, Ferry crossing over the Rhine River and land straight in front of Waldshut Old Town. (17.00 h 17.05 h). So, we escape from the heavy traffic which goes into Waldshut at this time of the day.
- English guided tour in the medieval town. The history of Waldshut spans almost 800 years. Our guide, Mrs. Simone Tröndle, will share with you exciting stories about places and people from the medieval past until this day. Come and explore this pearl at the foot of the Black Forest. Duration 1 hour.
- Good food at Restaurant Waldshuter Hof at (for us) affordable prices.
- Bus /Train ride from Waldshut to Zürich HB

Additional information:

Costs: For the guided tour, we ask for a contribution of CHF 5.00 and CHF 10.00 for quests.

The ferry over the Rhine River is € 3.20 p.p.

A good physical condition is required as we have to "climb" approx. 20 meters in altitude from the ferry station up to the Old town. Take a bottle of water with you as it may be hot at this time of the year. Don't forget your passport or ID!

Please buy two tickets:

Outward journey: Zürich HB – Full, Fähre (via Baden and Koblenz)
Return journey: Waldshut Bhf – Zurich HB (via Koblenz and Baden).
½ Tax Abo is valid in the German territory! Till late, we have buses leaving Waldshut – Koblenz every 30 minutes in the evening. This bus



runs on behalf of SBB - **So there is no risk of a strike!** Don't hesitate to ask if you have problems in finding the correct ticket for you. You may also add an "A-Welle Tageskarte if you already have an all over ZVV Ticket. We meet in Zürich HB in front of track 12 at 15.55 h. The train departs at 16.06 h.


Car drivers? Not recommendable. But you may park your car at the ferry station in Full.
