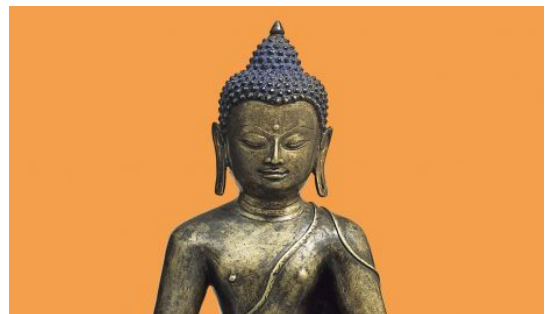

Between "light and shadow" at Haus Appenzell

Haus Appenzell invites you into the world of the old crafts: Hatter, shaver, saddler or white cooper – the special exhibition gives insights into familiar and forgotten professional worlds. Beautiful lanterns and artefacts from the guild's archives illustrate the historical influence of the guild system on the old occupational categories.

An artistic interpretation of the old crafts between light and shadow is presented by three artists from Eastern Switzerland: Also a look into the future is ventured: around 100 pupils from Appenzell (AI and AR), Schaffhausen and Zurich have designed lanterns with their own dream jobs drawn on them.

We will have an English guided tour lasting about 1 hour. The entrance fee is CHF 5.00 for members, guests pay CHF 10.00.
